Horsenden Children's Centre - Our Activities

Midwives Clinic

An initial appointment may be up to 2 hours, as the Midwife will explain the whole process of pregnancy and what you can expect from the Midwife service. Mums-to-be have follow-up appointments throughout the pregnancy, usually around 15 minutes, where the Midwife will check the health of the baby and the mother. After the baby is born, there are appointments to check that both mother and baby are healthy. The Midwives Clinics are by appointment only; to book an appointment, please call **020 8869 2871 or 020 8235 4252**

Weigh Only Clinic

Children should be weighed at:

- 3-4 weeks of age
- 8 weeks (at the GP)
- 12 and 16 weeks
- 6-8 months old
- 1, 2, 3 and 4 years old

You may be asked to bring your child more frequently by a Health Visitor. To book an appointment, please call **020 3313 7500 Monday - Friday between 2 pm - 4 pm.**

Our Stay and Play

groups provide a mix of play activities for children and parents/carers to enjoy together. The groups are for toddlers and children up to the age of 5 but younger brothers/sisters are welcome.

As well as general play, we also have a dedicated snack time, and a story/singing time.

The Agile Vibes

groups are also intended for toddlers and children under 5, although younger brothers/sisters are welcome.

They are run by Anjli, a qualified dance and Zumba instructor, who leads the children in dance and movement to music.

Parents/carers are encouraged to join in with the children.

For both groups, we have a suggested donation of £1 for each session.



We run **ESOL classes** for adults whose first language is not English.

These classes last for a whole school year (Sept to June), and we run them at different levels - Beginners to Advanced - depending on the demand.

For some classes, we provide a crèche for children whose parents/carers are attending the class.

We charge a fee for each course, to cover the costs of the textbook we provide and other materials used.
